Day One, Thursday

On arrival in the **Washington DC** metro area stop and visit the **Smithsonian’s Udvar-Hazy Center, National Air & Space Museum**. Later we’ll depart to check in to our hotel. Dinner is included this evening. C

Day Two, Friday

Breakfast is included at our hotel each morning. After breakfast depart to pay your respects to America’s departed servicemen & servicewomen at **Quantico National Cemetery** with a **flag placing event**. Continue to the **National Museum of the Marine Corps**. Enjoy lunch on your own in the Mess Hall (cafeteria) of the museum. After lunch depart for the **U.S. Capitol Building**, the **Library of Congress**, and the **Supreme Court Building**. Dinner is included this evening at a popular local restaurant. Arrive for seating at **Marine Barracks Washington DC** (*pending availability and weather—this is an outside event*). The ceremony begins with a concert by the **U.S. Marine Corps Band** followed by the **U.S. Marine Corps Evening Parade** and **Silent Drill Team**. Return to the hotel for the night. B,D

Day Three, Saturday

Depart and meet our guide at the **U.S. Navy Memorial**. Visit the memorial and **Naval Heritage Center**. Continue with stops at the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**, the **Korean War Veterans**

Memorial, and the **Lincoln Memorial**. Next we’ll stop at the **Air Force Memorial** on a hillside in Arlington, Virginia overlooking the Pentagon. Depart for the Pentagon and visit the **September 11 2001 Memorial**. Enjoy lunch on your own in the **Smithsonian museum** of your choice on the **National Mall**. After lunch visit the **museums of the Smithsonian Institution**—Air & Space, Natural History, American History, American Indian, African American Culture & History (opens 2015), and more. Tour the **National Archives** and see the original Declaration of Independence and Bill of Rights. Dinner is include at a very popular waterfront restaurant in historic Georgetown. After dinner walk through the **Kennedy Center** and take in the view of the city from the rooftop terrace. Stop at the **Iwo Jima Statue**, the **FDR Memorial**, and the **Jefferson Memorial** before returning to the hotel for the night. B,D

Day Four, Sunday

After breakfast check out and depart for a guided tour of **Arlington National Cemetery** by tram. Stop at the **Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldiers**. Continue with a **photo stop at The White House**. Next we’ll stop at the **National World War II Veterans Memorial**, the **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**, the **Korean War Veterans Memorial**, and the **Lincoln memorial**. After touring continue home. B
