Day One

Built in 1882, the Tudor-style Hotel Roanoke is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Fully restored, the hotel offers every modern convenience in the ambience of day long past. **D**

Day Two

After breakfast at the hotel we'll depart with our guide. Visit the world famous **Star of Roanoke**. Drive through the **historic neighborhoods**. Enjoy lunch on your own in charming downtown Roanoke where you will find many restaurants, cafés, and shops. After lunch continue with tours of the **Taubman Museum of Art** and the **Virginia Museum of Transportation**. Enjoy a private tour and dinner at the **O. Winston Link Museum**, displaying the collection of a dedicated photographer to who captured the waning days of steam railroading in America. **B,D**

Day Three

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out and departing for Lexington. Meet our **Lexington** guide and begin a tour of the **Virginia Military Institute (VMI)**, **Lee's Chapel**, the **George C Marshall Museum & Library**, and the **Stonewall Jackson House**. We'll enjoy lunch today on the campus of **Washington &**

Lee University. After lunch we depart for **Hot Springs** and arrive at the splendid **Homestead Resort & Spa** in time for afternoon tea. Surrounded by the four-season splendor of the Allegheny Mountains, this National Historic Landmark welcomed its first guests to the beautiful Virginia countryside a decade before the American Revolution. There is always some activity being offered at the Homestead you may opt to participate in. Enjoy dinner at the resort where gentlemen's required attire is a coat and tie. **B,D**

Day Four
